



## Damrow Chiropractic

Dr. Jim Damrow presented a history of Damrow Chiropractic Office, which is in its 90<sup>th</sup> year of business this year. Jim's grandfather EH Damrow, DC started the office in 1914 in downtown Janesville in the Jackman Block, which is now the home of the Brennan-Steil lawfirm. Chiropractic itself started just 19 years before that, when DD Palmer gave the first adjustment in Davenport IA. Damrow Chiropractic operated downtown until 1940, when it moved to the south side of Janesville to what used to be the Kellogg nursery. In 1950 Dr. Jack Damrow joined his dad in practice in a new building they built on the property. In 1992 Dr. Jim joined his dad, who then in retired in 1995. Jim remains in solo practice at 908 Conde street, on land that was part of the Kellogg farms that his grandfather bought in 1937.
