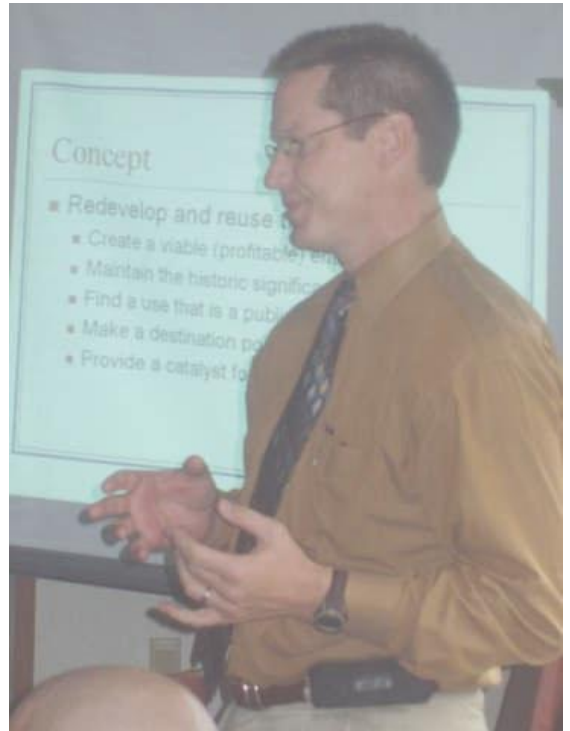
Mick Gilbertson gave a great presentation regarding 'The Armory'. The Armory will be opening in late October and includes:

The Armory, will be located in the Janesville Memorial Armory at 10 High Street. The Amory was built in the 1930s and housed the 192nd Tank Battalion during WWII. It is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.
