Tina Wies and her kids Bobby and Brianna informed us about Camp Hope and their visit last May. Camp Hope is a wonderful place in central Wisconsin where children from throughout the state gather to work through the grieving process after a loved one dies. Tina and the kids lost Ron Wies to a heart attack on October 16, 2004, he was 38 years old. The camp gently guides the children through the complex emotions by showing them that they are not alone.

Fun is the top priority at Camp Hope. The children learn that it is okay to laugh and play; and that to do so is not disrespectful to the memory of the person who died. Through playing, sharing, and being together with peers and staff who know the pain, the children realize that the emotions they are feeling are a normal part of grief.
