Judge Mike Fitzpatrick was with us today giving us a little insight into the "Law and Order" of Rock County. He has been on the bench since August of last year and is a criminal court judge. Our own DA David O'Leary and his team work in front of the Judge on a regular basis.

He wanted to become a judge to give back to the community and because he loves the law. One of the big differences in being a judge vs. a lawyer are the visits by law enforcement in the middle of the night looking for a signature on a warrant.

His "judicial philosophy" consists of 4 items: Work being done is extremely important, the judge should work harder than anyone else in the court, the hearing should be held in a civil and dignified manner, and finally the cases should be kept moving towards a conclusion within a reasonable amount of time.
