Merlin Kanter drew a non-Ace today, graciously leaving the pot intact for one more week.

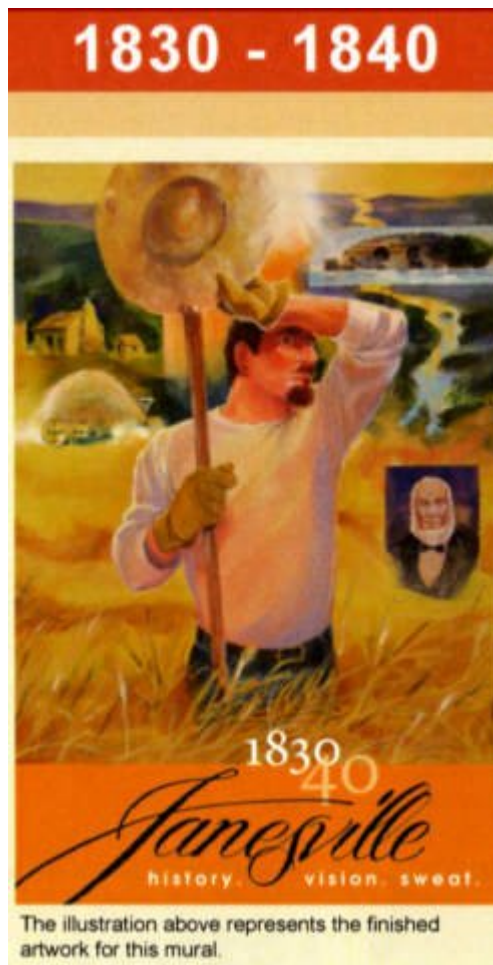
Program:

Chris Moore of the Janesville Design and Development Center (JDDC) was with us today to explain the "2009 Heart of the City Outdoor Art Campaign". The JDDC was responsible for

the Chevys on the Circuit campaign. This is the project that involved the creation and placement of the 39 mini '57 Chevys around the downtown a few years back.

The one common criticism received from that campaign was that the artwork did not stay in place. That was the beginning of this new campaign. Phase 1 of this campaign is to create 3 murals that will be placed in the downtown area. We were able to see mock ups of the murals in their future locations.



The theme of the first mural is the 1830s when the first settlers came to the Janesville area and started an agricultural community, growing mainly wheat. This 25' by 30' mural will be going on the north side of the building at 101 E. Milwaukee, facing the Janesville Farmers Market. Funding is needed and donations are tax deductible.
