Business Meeting Report:

A business meeting was held today for the purpose of voting on a proposal to raise the local club dues from the present \$20 per year to \$120.00 per year. This substantial dues increase was deemed necessary by the board, and recommended to the membership as the only way to keep the club's administrative fund in balance.

Secretary Ed Pulliam explained that, in the past, the club's practice of billing Active Members for meals, whether consumed or not, and billing Senior Members for at least 3 meals per Quarter, whether consumed or not, was covering the club guest meals, including Students, Prospective Members and Programs.

Now that we were going to bill all members only for meals consumed, a new dues structure was necessary.

The club voted unanimously to approve the dues increase as recommended by the board of directors.
